- 7. **Three (3) letters of support from your school teachers, school administrator, Pastor or employer
- 8. **Proof FAFSA Form has been completed and submitted.
- 9. Application and required documents must be post marked no later than the midnight February 15, 2020.

All scholarship recipients must seek to enrolled in a degree, certification or job placement program and have Letters of Acceptance from an accredited, 2yr/4yr college, technical or vocational school by the time United '74 Inc., has it's scholarship award program. Student classes must be scheduled to start at the beginning of fall school year immediately following their graduation from high school. Additionally, the selected candidate must remain fully eligible until they are fully and completely enrolled and have their class schedule from the school of their choice. Failure to do so will void the agreement with United '74 Inc. and the alternate candidate will be awarded if he or she is enrolled in an accredited college, technical or vocational school.

(Confirmation of school enrollment and scheduled courses will be verified prior to awarding scholarship).
